Winner of the 2015 William Petschek Recital Debut Award from the Juilliard School, Kramer is establishing himself as one of the most exciting young pianists on the concert stage today. Mr. Kramer holds both a Master's and a Bachelor's degree from The Juilliard School and an Artist Diploma from the Yale School of Music, where he received the Charles S. Miller Prize for outstanding first-year pianist. He is currently finishing his doctorate degree at the Yale School of Music. He has been the visiting artist in piano at Smith College and currently is Associate Professor of Piano at the University of Missouri Kansas City Conservatory of Dance and Music. His musical mentors have included Julian Martin, Robert McDonald, and Boris Berman.
