Top Pianists Perform in December and January

Vyacheslav Gryaznov and Andrew Li Next Up for Steinway Society's Home Concert Hall Series

SAN JOSE, CA— Vyacheslav Gryaznov, known for his creative, enthralling piano transcriptions, and Andrew Li, a celebrated young artist, will be the featured performers in December and January for Steinway Society — The Bay Area's new Home Concert Hall virtual series.

Each concert will be available during a four-day performance window. During that period, patrons will be able to view the recording as many times as they'd like. The artists will each give a short talk before their performances about their chosen pieces, while sharing information about their musical lives and how they are faring during the pandemic. A recorded pre-concert lecture by Bay Area classical music expert Dr. Gary Lemco will also be available for viewers to download.

Gryaznov: Back for An Encore Performance

Vyacheslav (called Slava by his friends) thrilled the audience in his West Coast debut with the Steinway Society in 2016, receiving three encores. He has performed to great acclaim throughout the U.S., Russia, Japan, and Europe, including Carnegie Hall and the Berlin Philharmonie. Slava studied at the Moscow Tchaikovsky Conservatory for his undergraduate and postgraduate degrees and earned the Yale School of Music's Artist Diploma in 2018. In 2014, he signed with Schott Music, GmbH & Co., where his transcriptions rank among the publisher's top ten best-selling piano editions.

Slava's performance, featuring his transcriptions of works by Bach, Beethoven, Mahler and Debussy, will be available from December 18-21, 2020.

Li: A Gift for Music Since Childhood

Andrew Li won first prize in the Bay State Piano Competition for five consecutive years from the ages of 7-12, and first prize for two consecutive years at the Steinway Competition in Boston. In October 2014, Andrew joined his older brother, George, in a performance at the recital series of Hamilton College. Andrew has won prizes in multiple piano competitions, including first prize at the Boston Symphony Orchestra youth concerto competition, second prize at the Hilton Head International Piano Competition, and third prize at the Minnesota Piano-e-Competition. In April 2018, he won first prize at the Harvard Music Association Achievement Awards.

Andrew's performance, featuring music of Beethoven, Chopin, and Brahms, will be available form January 22-25, 2021.
